In most cases, you will need to create references for at least five or more journal articles for every APA format paper you write. APA format details a set of clear rules for referencing articles that appear in academic journals and other periodicals. These vary somewhat based on where the article appears and who the authors are.

How to Reference Journal Articles in APA Format

List the title of the article in italics. Type the full title of the article in sentence case, capitalizing only the first word and any proper nouns in the title. If there's a subtitle, type a colon after the title followed by the subtitle, also in sentence case. Type a period at the end.

How to Properly Cite a Web Article in APA - wikiHow

For an APA citation for a journal article with 2 to 20 authors, use a comma between all of the author names. Place an ampersand (&) before the final author's name. For an article with 21 or more authors, list the names of the first 19 authors and use a comma between all of the names.

If you paraphrase or restate the idea in your own words, don't use quotation marks, but document the source. In the APA (American Psychological Association) format, one of several documentation formats, you briefly identify your sources in the text of your paper, then give the full information in the Reference List at the end

APA is the style of documentation of sources used by the American Psychological Association. This form of writing research papers is used mainly in the social sciences, like psychology, anthropology, sociology, as well as education and other fields.

Basic Form. APA style dictates that authors are named with their last name followed by their initials; publication year goes between parentheses,

followed by a period. The title of the article is in sentence-case, meaning only the first word and proper nouns in the title are capitalized.

An APA citation of web page reference includes the month, day, and year if it's a site that is updated with new information frequently. Blog posts, newspaper articles, posts from social media profiles, and YouTube videos are just a few of the sources that would display the full date.

APA 7th edition does not provide guidance on how to cite abstracts. However, if you only use information from the abstract but the full text of the article is also available, we advise you to add "[Abstract]" after the article or source name.

An APA in-text citation includes only three items: the last name (s) of the author (s), the year the source was published, and sometimes the page or location of the information. References include more information such as the name of the author (s), the year the source was published, the full title of the source, and the URL or page range.

If you are paraphrasing an idea from another work, you only have to make reference to the author and year of publication in your in-text reference, but APA guidelines encourage you to also provide the page number (although it is not required). According to Jones (1998), APA style is a difficult citation format for first-time learners.

Include an in-text citation when you refer to, summarize, paraphrase, or quote from another source. For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005).

The sixth edition provides explicit rules for direct quotations and states that you must credit the source when “paraphrasing, quoting an author directly, or describing an idea that influenced your work” (p. 170). If the quotation is less than 40 words, incorporate the quotation into the text and place quotation marks round the quotation.
