Initially it became the Corps of Intelligence Police (CIP). The (CIP) was later renamed and redirected into the US Army Counter Intelligence Corps (CIC) on January 1, 1942. CIC was heavily involved in the security of the Atomic Bomb development and the Normandy Invasion among others.

As a result of the general postwar Army reorganization, the Military Intelligence Officers Reserve Corps was established in the Organized Reserves on 2 April 1921. This organization was set up as a holding mechanism to keep intelligence specialists on tap in the event of a general mobilization.
