The California Trail started 60 miles north at St. Joseph, and was for the most part followed by men seeking to gain riches in the California goldfields.

## **Retracing the Oregon Trail - RV LIFE**

The Oregon Trail is a 2,170-mile (3,490 km) historic east-west, large-wheeled wagon route and emigrant trail in the United States that connected the Missouri River to valleys in Oregon. The eastern part of the Oregon Trail spanned part of the future state of Kansas, and nearly all of what are now the states of Nebraska and Wyoming.

By 1883 the Northern Pacific RR had reached the Portland area, Oregon and most of the reason for the once important trail disappeared. Now modern paved roads are built over or near most of the Oregon Trail as local travelers traveled to the now developed cities and towns originally established along the Oregon Trail.
